


IMMORTAL HISTORY OF DPRK-PRC FRIENDSHIP





The Democratic People's Republic of Korea and the People's Republic of China have a long history and tradition of bilateral friendship.

While waging an anti-Japanese revolutionary struggle in Northeast China and in the Mt Paektu area of Korea from the 1920s, Kim Il Sung, the founding father of socialist Korea, established relations of fraternal friendship with the Chinese people.

After Korea's liberation he dispatched the competent military and political workers, who had been trained and tempered in the anti-Japanese armed struggle, not to their motherland, but to Northeast China which was engulfed in the flames of war. Saying that to support the Chinese people in their revolutionary struggle was a noble internationalist duty of not only the Korean communists but also all other people of Korea, he had the selfless material aid given to them. True to his intention, hundreds of thousands of young Korean people unhesitatingly dedicated their youth and lives to the cause of the Chinese people.

When the Korean people were fighting against the allied imperialist forces, the Chinese people sent a large number of their excellent sons and daughters to the Korean front upholding the banner of resisting US aggression and aiding Korea, protecting the home and defending the motherland.

In the course of actively supporting and helping each other on the road for anti-imperialist independence, the DPRK and the PRC have consolidated their friendly relations into impregnable ones.

In the years when the two countries were striving to build a new society, Kim Il Sung and the leaders of the elder generations of the PRC steadily developed the friendly relations of the two countries on the basis of their comradeship, deep trust and unshakable revolutionary obligation.

Whenever he visited the PRC, Kim II Sung would meet the leaders of the party and state of the country, sharing views on the successes and experiences of socialist construction with them, and actively support all the successes the Chinese people had achieved in the creation of a new life. His counterparts, too, often visited the DPRK, deepening their friendship with him and expressing active solidarity with the Korean people in their struggle for socialism.

The Treaty on Friendship, Cooperation and Mutual Assistance between the DPRK and the PRC concluded on July 11, Juche 50 (1961) constituted a firm legal foundation for permanently developing friendly and cooperative relations between the two countries.

Today the DPRK-PRC friendly relations are developing comprehensively on a new strategic height with socialism, a common ideal of the peoples of the two countries, as their core.

It is an honourable tradition of the two countries that they have developed the militant ties and friendship in the common struggle for opposing imperialism and defending socialism.

The historic achievements of President Kim II Sung, who laid the cornerstone for DPRK-PRC friendship and devoted all his efforts to its development, will shine for ever with the garden of flowers of friendship.






Visit to the DPRK by Zhou Enlai

Zhou Enlai's visit served as an important opportunity for demonstrating the militant friendship and solidarity between the peoples of the two countries.









His visit served as a significant occasion in further developing on a higher level the friendship and unity between the two parties and countries, which had been established in the struggle for accomplishing the socialist cause.














